#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

American Sign Language is the Sign Language used by Deaf people in the United States and parts of Canada. The Lexington program is structured to help students learn American Sign Language by learning the vocabulary, sentences and grammar needed to communicate in common life situations. The pace is individual. Each adult student learns using expressive and receptive skills. At every level there is always a range of fluency and learning styles among students.

Two hour classes meet once a week for a ten-week semester. Enrollment is limited, and is based on a first-come, first-served basis according to the date registration/payment is received. **These classes are for adults only.**
